



Northern California Scholarship Information

For those members who are not aware, the Northern California (NorCal) Branch has a scholarship for purpose of supporting and advancing the educational and educational related activities of our NorCal members. It is called the “NorCal Clan Gunn Charitable Scholarship Fund”. The funds will be granted to individuals furthering the arts relating to Scottish culture and will be awarded as determined by the scholarship fund Board of Directors. In 2005, there were two scholarships awarded. There were no scholarships awarded in the years of 2006 and 2007. The application process is fairly simple.

The applicant must be ***a current family member or member of the NorCal Branch of the Clan Gunn Society of North America.*** The applicant must submit a completed written application, submit evidence of accepted enrollment in higher education of undergraduate or graduate study, or accepted enrollment in an advanced course of study for dance, voice, instrumental music, athletics, acting, etc. which enriches and enhances Scottish culture. The applicant must provide a transcript of class rank and of immediate past quarter or semester grades in secondary (high school) or higher education. Last, the applicant is asked for a narrative of no more than 500 words as to their Scottish related activities to date and how one’s course of study is related to Scottish history, industry or arts. The application must be received by July 15th preceding the academic term/year for which the scholarship is requested.
